TITLE: Worship Team Leader

REPORTING: Campus Pastor

STATUS: Part Time Non Exempt (10 hours a week)

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Acts as the primary liaison between the worship musicians and vocalists at the campus level. Plans and executes programming as outlined by the service programming director.

CHARACTER:

Has a clear call of God to lead the people of their community to Jesus Christ. Demonstrates the qualities of a follower of Jesus Christ, with a passion to love God and love others. Shows a strong commitment to living out Crossroad's values and beliefs in their everyday life. Possess characteristics that include: humility, teachability, organization, teamwork, discernment, wisdom and strategic agility. Must work extremely well with others.

EXPECTATIONS:

- 1. Build Volunteer Team** – Prayerfully recruits core volunteer leaders for large group, small group, special needs, check in, curriculum and technology. Invest in the team relationally; get to know them personally, help them to discover their gifting and discern their role within the team. Oversee the recruitment, orientation and ongoing development of volunteers. Coach them to love and serve families inside and outside of Sunday. Provide coaching necessary to create and maintain a healthy and Christ centered community.
- 2. Participate in Special Events** – Under the direction of the campus pastor participate on teams and help organize and execute specific events as directed.
- 3. Participate on Teams** – We are one church. Passionately participate on both campus level and churchwide teams as needed to carry out the mission and vision of the church.

DUTIES:

- Lead and develop campus musicians and vocalists
- Create a friendly and harmonious work environment
- Manage and maintain music charts and recordings
- Schedule teams
- Act as a liaison between the team and the service programming coordinator
- Manage music documentation for special events and services
- Be present on Sundays to lead and pour into the campus worship team
- Organize and maintain musical equipment
